Environmental Studies is a compulsory subject of 100 marks for B.A./B.Com./B.Sc.I. The degree of B.A. B.Com./B.Sc. will not be awarded without qualifying the Environmental Studies Paper.

Arts Faculty:

B.A. First Semester

Only those students are eligible for admission to B.A.-First Semester who have passed any of the following examination:

10+2 examination from Board of School Education. Haryana/CBSE/Any other board's equivalent examination with 35% marks.

Note: Failed candidates are not eligible for admission in the college.

Commerce Faculty:

B.Com. First Semester

Only those students are eligible for admission to B.Com.-First Semester who have passed any of the following examination:

10+ 2 examination from Board of School Education, Haryana/CBSE/Any other Board's equivalentexamination with 40% marks in Commerce Group or 50% marks in Arts/Science Group.

Science Faculty:

B.Sc. First Semester

Only those students are eligible for admission to B.Sc.-First Semester who have passed any of the following examination:

10+2 examination from Board of School Education, Haryana/CBSE/Any other Board's equivalentexamination with 40% marks in Science Group.

Candidate (s) placed under compartment in one subject only can be admitted provisionally to B.A./B.Com./B.Sc. 1st semester subject to passing their compartmental subject only in one subsequent chance as per provisions of the Kurukshetra University/Haryana Govt. Rules.

For B.A./B.Com./B.Sc- III-V Semester

The eligibility conditions will be determined as per the latest rules, regulations, guidelines of Kurukshetra

University, Kurukshetra/DHE, Haryana.

The students who have not passed all the papers of 1st semester of B.A./B.Com/B.Sc will not be promoted to B.A./B.Com/B.Sc. 5th semester class.

M.A.(English) First Semester

1. B.A.(Hons.) in English with 45% marks in aggregate

OR

- 2. Bachelor's degree with atleast 50% marks in aggregate or 45% marks in the subject of English
- 3. The candidate with compartment in lower exam will not be given admission in M.A.I.

RULES OF ADMISSION

- 1. The father/guardian must accompany the student at the time of admission and sign in the presence of the Principal the undertaking for the good conduct of the applicant.
- 2. Every student shall submit the declaration that he/she has not so far been admitted to any other college in the same class.
- 3. All columns should be clearly and legibly filled. Students belonging to SC/ST/BC should write the name of their caste. Wrong or incomplete information would deprive the student of all concessions/scholarships.
- 4. The following documents must be attached with admission form:
 - i) Two attested photocopies of the certificate of last examination
 - ii) Photocopy of Matric examination for the proof of date of birth and age.
 - iii) Original character certificate from the Principal of the institution last attended.
 - iv) Three recent passport size photographs pasted, not pinned or stapled on the spaceprovided for it.
 - V) Students belonging to SC/ST must attach a certificate issued by First Class Magistrate. Otherwise, they will have to deposit the full fee and funds like other students.
 - vi) Students migrating from other Universities/Boards shall have to submit migration certificatein original at the time of admission. -
- 5. All the original certificates must be produced at the time of admission.
- 6. If there is a gap year, original affidavit duly signed by the Magistrate First Class will have to be submitted.
- 7. Copy of Aadhar Card, Voter Card and Ration Card/BPL Card must be attached with the admission form.

Important:

- i) Admissions will be on purely merit basis, after fixing the number of students to be admitted ineach subject/course & class as per University norms.
- ii) The name of any student whose presence in the college is against the discipline of the college canbe struck off by the Principal.

- iii) The students must not conceal any information in the admission form, otherwise their admission can be cancelled at any time.
- iv) The decision of the Principal in any matter will be final.
- v) Students from other colleges will not be admitted to B.A./B.Com/B.Sc. 3rd, 5th semester classes.

ELIGIBILITY TO APPEAR IN THE EXAMINATION

As per University rules, University Examination shall be open to any student who:

1. Has attended not less than 75% of the full course of lectures and practicals separately delivered in his/her class. (The lectures to be counted upto the date of dispersal of classes)

2. Has satisfactorily performed his/her work in the college.

Note: Irrespective of what has been mentioned here, the rules received from the University from time to time will be followed. Changes if any, will be duly notified on the college notice board from time to time

INTERNAL ASSESSMENT

Internal assessment for B.A./B.Com./B.Sc. equal to 20% of total marks in each subject will begranted on the basis of attendance, assignments & class tests as per University rules.

The detail is as follows:

a) Two hand written assignments for B.A./B.Com./B.Sc. : 50% one seminar or one class Test for M.A.

b) One Class Test : 25%

c) Class Attendance : 25%

Marks of attendance will be as under:

65% to 69% - 1 mark 81% to 90% - 4 marks

70% to 74% - 2 marks 91% or above - 5 marks

75% to 80% - 3 marks

Note:

- a) If any students avails medical leave, he /she will submit the medical certificate from an MBBS doctor subject to the approval of the Principal. If he / she takes any other kind of leave, he / she will have to take the prior permission of the Principal.
- b) If any student remains absent from the class test/s he/she will be fined Rs. 100/- for each subject.
- c) Fee concession will be withdrawn of those students if they will not pass the class test/s.
- d) No prize will be awarded to those students if they use the unfair means material in the class test/s.
- e) 35% marks in Theory & 40% marks in Practical examinations separately are compulsory to pass their semester examination in each subject.
- f) 35% marks separately in internal assessment and theory examinations are required to pass the semester examination.

IMPORTANT:-

- 1. If a student fails to attend his/her classes continuously for seven days from the date of commencement of the classes or from the admission, his/her admission shall be cancelled.
- 2. Name of the student, who remains absent from his/her class for 14 days in a month in any subject will be struck off the college rolls.
