Detailed Report

With encouragement and guidance from the NAAC, Bengaluru, the Internal Quality Assurance Cell of Markanda National College Shahabad (M.) Haryana organized one-day Online National Webinar on the topic "A Critical Evaluation of Quality Sustenance in Higher Education Institutions in Imparting Education through Virtual Mode".

The inaugural session of the conference was graced by **Dr. Vinita Sahu**, Assistant Advisor, NAAC, Bengluru as Keynote Speaker. Dr. Ashok Kumar, Principal, Markanda National College presided the session. Dr. Amit Kumar, Convener of the Conference welcomed the delegates and guests. NAAC, Bengluru in detail. Dr. Jawahar Lal, delivered the vote of thanks to Keynote Speaker, all guests and delegates.

The First technical session was coordinated by Mrs. Bhavini Tejpal and Dr. Prachi Arora. Dr. Prachi Arora introduced the resource person, Dr. Vimal Rarh, Project Head and Joint Director, Guru Angad Dev Teaching- Learning Center of MHRD, Delhi University. She discussed about the Role of Teachers in Technology Empowered Higher Education. She precisely discussed the innovation, types of innovation, innovation through technology, pedagogy, inventions and creativity in terms of new thoughts, ideas and guiding principles in 21st century skills. She deliberated on the role of teachers in technology empowered education. She compared the ancient guru shishya prampara with the modern education system. Markanda National College, Shahabad- Markanda was established in 1971 by M.N. College Educational Society primarily to cater to the educational needs of this predominantly rural area. At that time, no college existed at Ladwa and even at Kurukshetra - the seat of Kurukshetra University, except University College, which had only brilliant urban students on its rolls. The establishment of this college proved to be a boon for this area. Ever since its inception, this college has not looked back and making significant strides, it has developed into a multifaculty institution, imparting instructions in English at Post-graduate level and in Arts, Science and Commerce Streams at under-graduate level. The college also runs successfully PG diploma in Yoga and two job-oriented add-on courses (i) Retail Management and (ii) Information and computer technology. The college is a co-educational institution affiliated to Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra and it is proud of its imposing infrastructure and an environment conducive to learning.
