

## EVALUATION OF ATTAINMENT OF COURSE OUTCOMS

### **METHOD OF EVALUATION**

There are two methods of assessment of the attainment of POs and COs of the programmes:

- 1. Direct Method
- 2. Indirect Method

Direct methods are provided through examinations or observations of student knowledge or skills against measurable course outcomes. The knowledge and skills described by the course outcomes are mapped to specific problems on University examinations, Internal Exams, and home assignments.

### Average Attainment in Direct Method :

In theory Subject Papers: University Examinations + Internal Assessment

The college uses tests and examinations to measure the attainment of program outcomes and course outcomes. Compulsory tests, two assignments per subject and final examinations are taken according to the schedule set by the university, which the institution strictly follows. Students are shown their answer books, made aware of their shortcomings and irrelevant elaborations, and advised on how to improve their answers. The answer books are evaluated, and marks are awarded. Discussion of important questions is held with the students prior to end semester examinations. Finally, the semester-end examination conducted by the affiliating university reflects the attainment gained by the students.

### ATTAINMENT OF COURSE OUTCOMES

The College adopts the following recommendations of the IQAC on the process of the attainment of COs which are given below:



Level 0: Less than 40 % of the students scored more than the overall class average in the End

Semester University Examination as well as Internal Assessment Marks


Level 1: 40-50 % of the students scored more than the overall class average in the End Semester

University Examination as well as Internal Assessment Marks

**Level 2: 50-60** % of the students scored more than the overall class average in the End Semester University Examination as well as Internal Assessment Marks

**Level 3: 60% and above** of the students scored more than the overall class average in the End Semester University Examination as well as Internal Assessment Marks
